Amendment #1: Changes are in *red* italics as follows:

11. MARKS

11.1 Marks shall be tetrahedron inflatable buoys. Marks A, B, and C shall be orange tetrahedrons.

17. PROTESTS

17.5 Location of notices, times and location of Protest meeting is as indicated in the host club SBC Regatta Amendment. The parties involved will be listed, in the order of filing, on the <u>NYCSD Regatta Network event</u> <u>"Notice Board"</u> and protests will be heard as soon as practicable, which will be at a later date and likely via ZOOM. This posting constitutes the notice required by RRS 63.2, Time and Place of the Hearing.

23. POST RACE ACTIVITIES
