


1. Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 All hails will use the last four digits of the sail number. If there is a duplicate, a "simple black line" under one of the sail numbers will be sufficient to indicate to the Race Committee that all six digits are required for identification.

2. Sailing Instructions

2.1 The sailing instructions [SIs] will be available before 1700 hours on a Aug 11, 2021, online through regatta network [rn] event https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22846.

3. Communication

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at the RN event URL above.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors using a hand held loud speaker.

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to Laser Standard, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7 (ILCA 7, 6, And 4).
- 4.2 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the online registration form on the official event website above.
- 4.3 Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver may be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.

4 Fees

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$80 for entries completed on or before 2000 hours August 11, 2021.
- 4.2 Entries received after 2000 hours August 11, 2021 will be subject to a \$20 late fee.
- 4.3 Registration closes as 1100 hours on August 14, 2021.

7.1 Boats may be inspected at any time for compliance with the International Laser Class Association Rules.

8 Venue

- 8.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys and fixed buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay.
- 8.2 The racing area will be within a 3 mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.
- 8.3 Information will be posted on the RN event URL to indicate locations for trailer and car parking, dry storage, and a racing area chart with fixed mark locations.

9 Courses

9.1 Courses, marks and roundings will be described in the SIs.

10 Penalty System

10.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 Scoring

- 11.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3 When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 Support boats

- 12.1 Support and coach boats must register at the Race Office during the check-in period.
- 12.2 During racing, support boats shall monitor the race committee VHF channel 68 and remain more than 50 yards from the course area, except when asked to assist by the race committee.
- 12.3 Support and coach boats shall berth as directed by the Santa Cruz Harbor Master.

13 Berthing

13.1 Boats shall be kept in the designated areas of berthing area. See SC Harbor Supplemental Information posted on event website.

14 Prizes

- 14.1 Prizes will be given to the overall winners in each registered class division.
- 14.2 The number of prizes will be adjusted to suit the number of competitors pre-registered in each division. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

15 Risk, disclaimer of liability, & personal conduct

- 15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk (see Rule 4, Decision to Race).
- 15.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 15.3 Competitors will accept full responsibility for all their actions during any activity related to this event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
