

Sailing Instructions

1. Schedule

1.1 Competitor briefing will be held on the SCYC upper deck at 1000 hours Saturday August

2. Courses and Marks

- 2.1 A description of the courses to be sailed is described in Figure 1.
- 2.2 The course to be sailed will be signaled using numeral pennants.
- 2.3 Marks G1, G2 comprise a gate. If one mark is missing the remaining mark is to be rounded to port.

3. Start and Finish

- 3.1 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the signal vessel and mark S.
- 3.2 The finishing line will be between an orange flag on the signal vessel and mark F.

4. Class Flag

- 4.1 The Laser class flag will be a red laser insignia on a white background.
- 4.2 The Radial class flag will be a red laser insignia on a green background.

5. Signals Made Ashore

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the SCYC flagpole.

6. Communications

- 6.1 The Race Committee may hail, on a hand held loud speaker, the sail number or other identifying feature of any boat that was on the course side of the starting line at her start signal. The failure of a hail, the failure of a boat to hear a hail, or the order of the hail(s) shall not be grounds for a boat to request redress. This changes RRS 62.1.
- 6.2 Race results will be posted on the event URL https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/22846 and the SCYC Notice Board located in the NE corner window on the upper deck.

7. Changes to the Sailing Instructions

- 7.1 Changes to the sailing instructions will be posted on the event URL not less than 60 minutes prior to the first scheduled race of the day it will take effect.
- 7.2 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 hours on the day before it will take effect.


8. Time Limits

8.1 A boat that fails to finish within fifteen (15) minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

9. Protests

- 9.1 The protest filing time limit will be 60 minutes after the arrival of the signal vessel at dock and will be posted on the SCYC Notice Board.
- 9.2 Hearing request forms are available at the regatta shed located in the dry storage yard below the SCYC.
- 9.3 Notices will be posted on the Notice Board no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of a hearing in which they are parties.
- 9.4 The location of the hearing(s) will be posted on the Notice Board.

Figure 1: COURSE DIAGRAM






Figure 2: MARKS AND COURSES

O (offset)	Round red ball
G1, G2 (gate)	Yellow tetrahedrons
R (reach)	Orange tetrahedron
L (leeward)	Yellow tetrahedron
F (finish)	Round red ball
SV (Signal Vessel)	Signal Vessel

2	S – W – O – L – W – O – L - F
3	S – W – O – gate – W - O - L - F
4	S – W – O – R - L - F
5	S – W – O – gate – W- O - R -L - F
