1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Appendix T, expedited hearings will be in force.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 All One Design Boats, limited to 5 classes at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 2.2 **We invite the Tartan 101 fleet and the J109 fleet to race as a single fleet for one day.**
- 2.3 Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the fleet in which it competes.

- 2.5 Entry fee is \$20 payable on regatta Network.

3. CLASSES

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC.org and Regatta Network no later than 2000 hours on Thursday August 5.

6. COURSES

- 6.1 Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks.
- 6.2 The course will be North of the Marina del Rey Spar buoys.
- 6.3 There will be 5 or more races for all classes.
- 6.4 Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as weather allows.

7. PENALTIES

Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.

9. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race.

10. HOSPITALITY
