## Notice of Race

- 1. **Rules** This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024 including the prescriptions of US Sailing and the Wianno Senior Class Rules, except as modified by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. **Eligibility** This regatta is open to all Wianno Seniors.
- 3. **Registration** Registration is required and will be available from the Regatta Network and/or Wianno Senior Class website.

## 4. Schedule of Events

- <u>5.</u> <u>Sailing Instructions</u> The Sailing Instructions for the Regatta will be available at the Wianno Senior Class Association and/or Regatta Network website.
- <u>6.</u> <u>Courses</u> Courses and Racing Areas will be delineated in the Sailing Instructions
- <u>7. Class Rules</u> In accordance with Class rules, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
- 8. **Lunch** Lunch will be provided each day at the Yacht Club starting at 10:00. There will be a cocktail party after the race on Saturday at the Yacht Club.

- <u>9.</u> Launch Launch service will be available starting at 9:00 A.M. Saturday and Sunday morning. If you plan to arrive on Friday, and will require a launch, advise us of your ETA by calling Mark Ahern at (508)776-2112. Please let us know should you plan to arrive Sunday afternoon after the Hyannis Port Wianno Senior Regatta.
- 10. **Docks and Moorings** We anticipate having a dock or mooring available for all participants. There will be launches about on Saturday morning and afternoon to direct you as necessary. Ralph Lincoln (603-828-2948), Rick Crawford (508-737-0194), and Bob Churchill (508-776-8686) are coordinating this effort. If you wish to anchor, anchoring is available in any open area, and the holding ground is generally good. Avoid the areas around Stage Island. It is shallow at low tide and the currents tend to be stronger there. Keep in mind that this is a tidal river. Use chain and plenty of scope, but stay away from moorings, which tend to have shorter lines.
- 11. **Yacht Club Floats** Do not plan on tying up on the face of the yacht club dock, it is for touch and go's only. The face is reserved for club race committee boats.
