NOTICE OF RACE

As amended 7/10/21 to incorporate the changes of Amendment #1

RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Racing Association (STCR).

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website no later than 1600 Thursday, September 30.

COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The official notice board is located at the TAYC clubhouse.
- 3.2. All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 16, 68, 69, 71, 72 and 78A.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4. From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to Star Class boats that comply with STCR 21 and 26.4.
- 4.2. Eligible boats are encouraged to register online by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event by 1500 Friday, October 1.All registrations must be completed online. If a **Novice Skipper** (as defined by STCR 23.7.1), please **identify yourself** on entry form.
- 4.3 A Competitor is not entered and will not receive a score until all fees are paid.

FEES

5.1. The entry fee is \$155 per boat payable no later than 0900 October 2. Entry fee includes Continental breakfast Saturday & Sunday, Saturday Buffet Dinner with

Chicken Marsala and Grilled Salmon Filet. Saturday post-race cash bar available. On Sunday, there will be post-race hors d'oeuvres and cash bar.

ADVERTISING

6.1. Boats may be required to display a Charles Schwab sticker supplied by the organizing authority.

MEASUREMENT

- 8.1. Boats and sails shall comply with all aspects of the ISCYRA rules.
- 8.2. Teams will not be held to STCR 31.1.3.

THE VENUE

9.1. Racing will be in the Tred Avon River or the Choptank River S/SW of the Choptank River Light, depending upon weather.

SCORING

- 10.1. RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 10.2. Three races must be completed to constitute the regatta.
- 10.3. If more than 4 races are completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded from her total score.

LAUNCHING

- 11.1. Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of the hoist and access lanes. No vehicles may drive on dock.
- 11.2. Once launched, boats may haul-out after Saturday's racing or remain in the water over night at TAYC's docks.

PRIZES

- 12.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1, 2 and 3 overall for the weekend.
- 12.2. Special prizes may also be awarded:

AB Streeton Trophy: Winning boat after Saturday's racing.

North Emory Bartlett Trophy: Winning boat for Sunday's races.

Novice Skipper: Best overall score among novice skipper.

12.3. Prizes will be presented at the TAYC clubhousefollowing Sunday's racing. Results will be posted at www.tayc.com/racing.

13. SPECIAL COVID-19 REGATTA RULES

13.1. Current state and local requirements for protection against the transmission of Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta. Masks and social distancing are recommended for those who have not been fully vaccinated.
