1 The Race Office will be in the Blackbeard Sailing Club building.

The Flag pole on which signals made ashore will be located at the south eastern corner of the rear deck of the Clubhouse.

2 Schedule

Saturday August 28

0900 Competitors' Meeting on the deck at BSC Clubhouse.

1130 Warning Signal for the first race. Other races to follow

No races to start after 1530.

1800 Dinner at the BSC Clubhouse.

Sunday August 29

0745 Continental Breakfast at the BSC Clubhouse.

1000 Warning Signal for the first race. Other races to follow.

No races to start after 1230

3 Class Flags

Class flags for starting purposes will be announced at the Competitors' Meeting and posted on the Official Notice Board immediately thereafter.

4 Marks

The weather mark will be a 5' orange tetrahedron

The offset mark will be a 3' orange tetrahedron

The change mark will be a 5' yellow tetrahedron. There will not be an offset mark with the change mark.

The leeward mark will be a 5' yellow tetrahedron.

The finish line will be between a blue flag on the finish boat and a 3' yellow tetrahedron.

The courses to be sailed and the marks to be rounded are depicted in Appendix 1

5 Time limits

The time limit for the first boat in each class to start, sail the course and finish is 90 minutes.

The time limit for boats to finish after the first boat in each class starts, sails the course and finishes is 15 minutes. Any boats still racing will be scored in place by the Race Committee which shall not be subject to protest.

6 Verbal Changes to the Sailing Instructions

The Race Committee can make verbal changes to the Sailing Instructions. They shall display Flag L and advise all competitors affected by the change and get their acknowledgement.

7 Courses

The courses are shown in Appendix 1 which shows the marks, the side on which they are to rounded and the order of rounding.

The course to be sailed will be displayed on the starboard side of the Signal Boat
