1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the rules of Southern Massachusetts Sailing Association, this Notice of Race (NOR), and by the Sailing Instructions (SI).
- 1.2. Advertising shall be in accordance with ISAF's Regulation 20, Advertising Code, and the relevant class rules.

2. SAFETY

- 2.1. All competitors and coaches must wear properly fastened USCG approved Type III non inflatable life jacket at all times while on the water, except to quickly change clothing.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. Regatta is open to the following classes: Club 420 & Optimist
- 3.2. 420 competitors shall not reach their 19th birthday during the 2021 calendar year.
- 3.3. No registration will be considered complete until all fees are received.
- 3.4. No registration will be considered complete until each boat performs the mandatory check-in.

4. FEES

Includes Dry Bag for Bring your own Lunch

Entry Fee (ends Monday August 2nd, 2021): Late fee will be in effect for August 3rd

-\$60 per competitor (exception: \$50 for Optimist Green competitors)

****Lunch will not be provided.** In an effort to cut down on waste, competitors will be asked to bring your own lunch and use the gifted regatta dry bag as storage**

5. GREEN REGATTA

DBMS is trying to do its part to promote an environmentally sound sailing program. Please plan to bring reusable water bottles. Water fill stations will be available during the regatta.

7. REGISTRATION

7.1. Mandatory onsite check in will be held at DBMS on Saturday, August 7 from 0730 – 0900 for all entered sailors to complete registration.

7.2. All visiting coaches are required to check-in with the regatta registrars on Saturday, August 7 from 0730 – 0900.

8. BOAT & TRAILER DROP OFF

8.1. Boats may be dropped off at the regatta site after 1600. on Friday, August 6. *Please check in at the front desk before leaving boats at the site.*

8.2. Trailers must be stored off site at 71 Alden Street. Further instructions are posted to regattanetwork.com.

9. REGATTA PARKING/SHUTTLE SERVICE

No parking will be allowed at the venue. Parking is available at 71 Alden Street, and a shuttle will be running every 15 minutes to transport individuals to and from.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in & are posted online at regattanetwork.com.

11. COURSES

The courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions, posted on the notice board, and posted online at regattanetwork.com.

12. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A, as changed in this paragraph, will be used. One race shall be completed to constitute a series. If fewer than five races are completed, there will be no discard. There will be one discard for every 5 races completed.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to each competitor finishing first through third. *All Green fleet participants will receive an award.*
