NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the rules of the Chesapeake Bay Log Sailing Canoe Association (CBLSCA).

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by 1600 on August 21 and in the clubhouse on race days.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 16, 68, 69, 71, 72 and 78A.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats owned by members of the CBLSCA having current measurement certificates.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event. Log Canoes are invited to participate without registration fees. The \$2 registration fee prompted by Regatta Network will be refunded following registration.
- 4.3 Entry forms must be received no later than 0900 Saturday, August 28. On-line registration is required.

5 SCHEDULE

Saturday:

5.3	1030	Warning signal, Race 1
5.4	1200-1600	Ala carte lunch / cash bar
5.5	1430	Warning signal, Race 2
5.6	1600	After racing lite fare, cash bar

Sunday:

- 5.7 0800-0930 Free continental breakfast. Breakfast sandwich available for purchase for \$6.
- 5.8 1030 Warning signal, Race 3

6 THE VENUE

6.1 Log canoes will race in the Tred Avon River generally between Choptank River light and the entrance to Plaindealing Creek. Both government and drop marks may be used.

7 SCORING

7.1 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

8 PRIZES

- Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 8.2 Prizes will be awarded following racing on Sunday. Results will be posted at www.tayc.com/racing.

9 **SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- 9.1 All canoes shall have a chase boat/tender with life jackets for all crew.
- 9.2 All canoes must have a life ring or throwable cushion with a rope attached. Any crew who cannot swim must wear a life jacket.
- 9.3 A boat that retires or leaves the racing area between races shall notify the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 9.4 Current state and local requirements for protection against the transmission of
- 9.5 Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta. Masks and social distancing are recommended for those who have not been fully vaccinated.
- 9.6 It is the sole responsibility of the owner and/or skipper to ensure that these safety requirements are met.
