**Management and Rules**

The organizing Authority for this event is the Pensacola Beach Yacht Club (PBYC) and will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the 2020 Pensacola Bay Sailing Instructions, except as modified by this Notice of Race and or Sailing Instructions published for this event.

**Classes**

Classes will be decided based on participants. A class options will be; GYA PHRF Spinnaker (Big Mouth), GYA PHRF NoN-Spinnaker (short course), Multihull. A minimum of three entries are required to make a class. Class divisions will be announced at the Skipper's Meeting or on the water the day of the race. Scratch sheets will be provided as available.

**Scoring**

Race scoring will be based on PHRF TOD, Portsmouth and one design will apply.

**Trophies**

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third places in each class. First overall Corrected (Big Mouth) will be awarded to the overall corrected time winner in the Spinnaker division. First boat to finish (Big Mouth) will be awarded to the First boat to finish in the Spinnaker Division. The Skunk Flag will be awarded to the last boat to finish.

**Special Notes**

---

1. Multihull boats are not eligible for the PHRF Big Mouth Trophy.
2. Multihulls are not required to honor the shoal marks identified in the Pensacola Bay Sailing Instructions. The winner of the multihull Big Mouth award will be the first PBYC boat to finish in the multihull class sailing the long course to the seabuoy.
3. Boats competing for the Big Mouth trophies are require to be skippered by a PBYC Member.
4. Bring a fast boat!
