## **Notice of Race**

**Organizing Authority**: Lewes Yacht Club and Hobie Fleet 24 will be the organizing authority.

**Rules**: Racing shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of the International Hobie Class Association. Competitors are reminded that per IHCA class rule 26, at least one crew member per boat shall be a paid member of the Hobie Class Association. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

**Eligibility and Entry**: This event is open to all class legal Hobie Wave's, Hobie 14's, Hobie 16's, Hobie 17's, Hobie 18's, Hobie 20's, Hobie Tiger and Wild Cat

#### Fees:

All fees will be paid via Regatta Network. Please register on line prior to the event.

Double handed: \$65 Single handed: \$50

Youth: free (Youth are defined as all crew under the age of 21 years as of December 31 of the year the event

begins.)

HCANA membership required for points and **free** if skipper's first Hobie regatta.

### Schedule:

Saturday

Registration 8:30 to 9:30 AM Competitors meeting at 10am First race Not before 11:00 AM

Sunday

Competitors meeting 9:30am (only if needed)

First race not before 10:00 AM

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When more than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

The objective is 3-5 races per day. There is no maximum number of races scheduled.

**Sailing Instructions**: Sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board and available on site.

#### Radio communication

Competitors may bring and use VHF radios. Their use and restrictions shall be described in the Sailing Instructions.
