1 Rules

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), including the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as noted and changed by the sailing instructions.

5 Venue

Racing will be on and around the Intercoastal Waterway, locally known as the Halifax River, between the Orange Avenue Bridge and the Dunlawton Bridge.

6 Course

The course for this distance race will be approximately 8 miles. The specific details for the course will be explained during the skipper's meeting.

7 Scoring

The distance race regatta will be comprised of only one race. Each boat's time will be corrected in accordance with the Portsmouth rating of that boat to arrive at a corrected time to be used for scoring.

8 Awards

- 8.1 Awards will be given to the top boat in each class: centerboard dinghy, keelboat, and multihull.
- 8.2 The Thunder Mug perpetual trophy will be awarded to the boat with the fastest corrected time.
- 8.3 The Founders Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the youth sailor with the fastest corrected time.
