1 Rules

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), including the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as noted and changed by the sailing instructions.

1.2 USCG approved life jackets must be worn while on the water.

2 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 Registration will be available on Regatta Network and also onsite the morning of the competition.

2.2 This race is open to all boats with a valid Portsmouth rating.

2.3 Any modification a competitor makes to a boat that violates its class's rules must make note of the modification on the registration application.

3 Fees – Please register online BEFORE 8/21/21 to receive the discount, do not pay until the day of the race at check in. Checks or cash accepted. Sorry, no credit cards.

3.1 Adult Multi-Crew: \$40 (Early registration discount fee - \$30 by 8/20/21).

3.2 Adult Singlehanded: \$30 (Early registration discount fee - \$20 by 8/20/21).

3.3 Youth Sailors (17 years of age and younger): \$25 (Early registration discount fee - \$15 by 8/20/21).

5 Venue

Racing will be on and around the Intercoastal Waterway, locally known as the Halifax River, between the Orange Avenue Bridge and the Dunlawton Bridge.

6 Course

The course for this distance race will be approximately 8 miles. The specific details for the course will be explained during the skipper's meeting.

7 Scoring

The distance race regatta will be comprised of only one race. Each boat's time will be corrected in accordance with the Portsmouth rating of that boat to arrive at a corrected time to be used for scoring.

8 Awards

8.1 Awards will be given to the top boat in each class: centerboard dinghy, keelboat, and multihull.

8.2 The Thunder Mug perpetual trophy will be awarded to the boat with the fastest corrected time.

8.3 The Founders Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the youth sailor with the fastest corrected time.

9 Disclaimer of Liability

All competitors will be required to sign a waiver of liability as a condition of entry. Parents / guardians must sign for competitors under 18 years of age.
