

# THE OUTLAW REGATTA

The Outlaw Regatta is a premier 30 mile, down the coast race from Marina del Rey to Seal Beach at Alamitos Harbor.

**SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2021**

## NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authorities are:

### 1. **Rules:**

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) "Marine Industry Racer Rule" will not apply.

### 2. **Eligibility:**

- 2.1. This race is open to boats with a 2021 PHRF Certificate.
- 2.2. To be eligible for entry, each boat must:
  - (a) be entered by an individual who is a member of US Sailing or other organization affiliated to US Sailing or to SCYA (or their own National Authority); and
  - (b) have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate with an OWC rating not to exceed 198; or Information about joining PHRF SoCal is available at [www.phrfsocal.org](http://www.phrfsocal.org) or at 562.438.6712); or

### 3. **Entry:**

- 3.1. Eligible boats must enter the race on Regatta Network.
- 3.2. <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23120>
- 3.3. Entries must be received by 2000 on Wednesday, September 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 3.4. The entry fee is \$45.00 or \$40.00 for US Sailing Members.
- 3.5. Late entries may be accepted with Race Chair approval and a \$15.00 late fee after the entry deadline.

### 4. **Classes:**

- 4.1. Classes will be established based on entries received prior to 2000 hours Wednesday, September 1<sup>st</sup>. Expected classes include PHRF, Cruising spinnaker and Cruising non spinnaker.
- 4.2. A minimum of 4 paid entries will be required to establish a class. Entries that have not met the minimum may be assigned to another appropriate class.
- 4.3. Classes, class flags and the order of starts will be posted on the official notice board outside the main office at Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club and online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23120> or [www.smwyc.org](http://www.smwyc.org) no later than 1800 hours on Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>.

### 5. **Schedule:**

Friday September 3, 2021 at 1800

Pre race party on the patio of SMWYC

Saturday, September 4, 2021:

The scheduled time of the 1<sup>st</sup> Warning Signal is 1125.

Cut off time is 1900 hours.

The trophy presentation will be at Seal Beach Yacht Club followed by a delicious dinner and a live band. *Pirate costumes are encouraged and awards for the best dressed will be awarded.*

## **6. Sailing instructions:**

Sailing Instructions will be available at [www.smwyc.org](http://www.smwyc.org) or posted at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23120> no later than 1800 hours on September 1, 2021.

## **7. The Course:**

- From Start Line near H Mark, leaving the El Segundo buoy R“2ES”, the PV buoy R“10PV” and Point Fermin buoy “R6” to Port to the finishing line in Alamitos Bay.
- A line connecting the Alamitos Bay Jetty mid-channel buoys is a continuing obstruction not to be crossed and shall be left to port. The handicap distance will be 29.9 Miles

## **8. Scoring:**

For PHRF Classes Off-Wind Course Base (OWC) rating will apply.

For Cruising Non-Spinnaker Classes, the PHRF So Cal offset will apply.

## **9. Radio Communication:**

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, channel 71, including starting penalties.

## **10. Awards:**

10.1. Trophies will be awarded in each class.

10.2. An overall winner in PHRF Racing Classes (not Cruising) will be awarded the perpetual “Down the Coast” trophy for the best overall corrected time.

10.3. **RUM** will be awarded for the best Pirate Costume and Pirate Boat.

## **11. Docking:**

Entrants requiring slips shall make their own arrangements as follows:

Note: in both Marina del Rey and in Long Beach efforts are being made to acquire free slips for the “Outlaw Eve” and “Post Outlaw”. If free accommodations are not available contact the marinas listed below.

### **Marina del Rey:**

For free guest slips *first come/first serve* contact Stephen McDonough at [race@smwyc.org](mailto:race@smwyc.org) with boat owner/skipper name, boat name, telephone contact, Documentation/CF number, type of boat, length of boat

Slips are available at Burton Chase Park on a first come, first serve basis. Park your boat and walk up to the office. You will need your documentation/registration and an ID. The cost is \$1.15 per ft/per night

**In Long Beach:** For free guest slips for ONE night (9.4.21) contact Port Captain, John Huntington, at 562-234-7150 with above information

Slips are available for extended stays through the reservation system up to 30 days in advance. You can call [562-570-3215](tel:562-570-3215), or email [alamitosbaymarina@longbeach.gov](mailto:alamitosbaymarina@longbeach.gov). You will need documentation/registration and proof of insurance. The cost is \$1.20 per ft/per night.
