COVID-19 STATEMENT

Covid-19: Per recommendations of the CDC, State of Georgia, US Sailing, SAYRA, and ASC, specific Covid-19 protocols will be followed. All members and guests are encouraged to wear face masks if unable to socially distance by 6 feet or more. The safety and health of each member is the responsibility of the individual. Rules: Racing is governed by the USSA RACING RULES OF SAILING for 2021-2024, USSA Prescriptions, individual class rules, and Sailing Instructions (SI available online and posted outside of the ASC clubhouse).

Classes Expected: Racing is open to Sunfish, Open Skiff, Laser/Laser Radial, 420, C Scow, MC Scow, E Scow, PHRF

Classes of Five or more will sail and be scored as class. Miscellaneous dinghies will sail and be scored within the Portsmouth fleet. PHRF fleets will be scored Time on Time.

Juniors will Start and finish on the Main Course. Junior Course marks will be designated in the competitors meeting and posted on the committee boat. For every 6 races completed on the Junior Course, one race will be thrown out.

The low point scoring system Rule A-2 will apply modified so that each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores in all races. One race will constitute a regatta. If a race "times out" the boats not finishing the race in the time allotted will be scored one point more than the number of boats finishing in the time allowed. This modifies RRS A4.2.

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Fees: Base entry fee for the Regatta is \$20 per boat, Junior skippers ≤ 18 years of age \$10

Registration: Registration will be on-line only and will close at 6pm, Friday, September 3rd. ASC has adopted an online registration and payment system. Payment is made at the time of registration via the Club Web Portal. Please register early.

Schedule: A competitors skippers meeting will be held 10:00 AM at the ASC Clubhouse on Saturday, September 4th. The race start sequence will begin no earlier than 12:00 PM Saturday, September 4th and 12:00 PM Sunday, September 5th.

Courses: Courses will be described at the Saturday skippers meeting and posted on the committee boat.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in each fleet on Sunday, September 5th.

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
