

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Albacore, A-Class, F16, F18, Flying Scot, Chesapeake 20, Club 420, and Laser (full and radial rigs will be race together unless fleet size permits) classes.
- 2.2 Any sailor who is has recently shown symptoms, is awaiting results, or actively shows symptoms of Covid-19 is not permitted to compete.

3 ENTRY

- 3.1 Registration **must** be completed on the regatta's webpage (link below). The club will not provide access to a computer, tablet, or smart phone, so it is highly recommended to complete the registration and payment before coming to the event.

- 3.2 Registration will close at 0900 on Saturday, September 4th.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Fees must be paid online prior to the close of registration. Cash and checks will not be accepted.

The Race Committee (RC) will announce the order of starts for the first race at the competitors' meeting.

8.2 Sunday

1030 First warning signal
1500 No races will start after this time
Scores will be posted follow racing. Awards will follow soon after.

8.3 Number of Races:

There is no limit to the number of races. The committee will attempt to maximize racing for the conditions available.

9 PRIZES

9.1 For each class, prizes will be given to the first-place finisher in classes with three or fewer entries, the first two finishers in classes with six or fewer entries, and the first three finishers in classes with seven or more entries. The Billy Heintz Memorial perpetual trophy will be awarded to first place finisher in the class with the largest number of registered competitors.

10 COURSES

10.1 Courses will be set around racing marks as declared in the Sailing Instructions and Appendix A.

11 PENALTIES

11.1 The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty'
