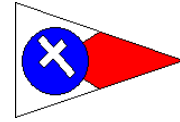

### **2019/2020 SCYC CLIFF McNAMARA CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS INVITATIONAL Saturday, September 25<sup>th</sup> 2021**

## **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

### **1 Rules**

- 1.1 This Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Appendix A2.1 is changed per Sailing Instruction 10.2.

### **2 Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 This is an Invitational Regatta for boats that have won a class in a SCYC series or regatta in the 2019/2020 seasons or the 2020/2021 Midwinters regatta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats must enter on-line at [scyc.org/racing](http://scyc.org/racing) prior to 1030 September 22<sup>nd</sup> 2021.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$40.00 and is non-refundable.
- 2.4 If a boat does not have a valid Monterey Bay PHRF rating, a rating will be assigned by the Race Committee at the Competitors' Meeting.

### **3 Communication with Competitors**

- 3.1 A Competitors' Briefing will take place at 1100 on Saturday September 25, 2021 at the SCYC Clubhouse. Official Notices will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board located in the window at the Northeast corner of the clubhouse.
- 3.2 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1130 hours on race day. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the yardarm of the mast on the SCYC clubhouse deck.
- 3.3 On the water, the Race Committee will use VHF 68 for communication.

### **4 Schedule**

- 4.1 One race is scheduled.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3 An awards ceremony will take place at the SCYC Clubhouse following the regatta.

### **5 Racing Area**

The racing area will be within a three mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

### **6 The Course**

- 6.1 The courses and marks are described on Attachment A – Description of Marks and Courses.
- 6.2 Courses will be signaled with a numerical pennant.

### **7 The Start**

- 7.1 The class flag shall be Code Flag F.
- 7.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee signal boat and a nearby yellow mark.

## **8 Checkout**

- 8.1. A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

## **9 The Finish**

- 9.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee signal boat and a nearby red mark.

## **10 Penalty System**

- 10.1. RRS rule 44.1 us changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **11 Protests**

- 11.1 US SAILING Protest Forms will be available at the SCYC Regatta Shed. The filing period for protests shall expire one hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks.
- 11.2 The time and place of all protest hearing(s), the boat(s) protesting, boat(s) being protested and boat(s) requesting redress will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board within 60 minutes after the docking of the Race Committee Signal Boat. This shall serve as notification as per RRS 63.2.

## **12 Scoring**

- 12.1 One race shall constitute the series.
- 12.2 No scores will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.1.
- 12.3 A boat's finishing position will be determined by her corrected time based on PHRF time on distance.

## **13 Awards**

- 13.1 There will be two awards presented. One will be to boats that qualified in 2019 and one for boats that qualified in 2020. The overall winner from each year will be designated the winner of the Champ of Champs for that year and will have the boat name affixed to the perpetual trophy.
