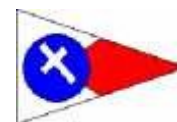

Notice of Race

1. Rules

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The series is open to any boat holding a valid Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- 2.2 There will be the following PHRF divisions: A Fleet (77 or less), B Fleet (greater than 78), Double Handed, Jib & Main (181 or less) and Jib & Main (greater than 181).
- 2.3 Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons on board.
- 2.4 Other divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form for the event listed at: www.scyc.org/racing

3. Fees

- 3.1 The regular entry fee is \$105.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Aug 24, 2021.
- 3.2 The late entry fee is \$135.00 and is applicable to all entries received after the above time.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1100 hours on Oct 24, 2020.
- 3.4 Competitors may sign up to compete in a single Fall Score Series race by paying a single entry fee of \$40.

4. Schedules

- 4.1 A Regatta Briefing will be held at 2000 hours on Friday, Aug 27, 2020 on Zoom. The link will be posted on line.
- 4.2 Scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours on Aug 29 in Moss Landing, 1225 hours each subsequent race day.
- 4.3 Three races are scheduled; one race on each day.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available online at www.scyc.org/racing (referenced above).

6. Venues

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to ten miles off shore.
- 6.2 The starting area for August 29 will be between Moss Landing entrance buoy "1" (Green Can) and the "MLA" safe water buoy (Bell buoy). Subsequent races will begin at SCYC Start/Finish mark in Monterey Bay, Santa Cruz.

7. Scoring

- 7.1 Three races constitute a series.
- 7.2 A boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

8. Prizes

- 8.1 A daily first place prize will be awarded for each division.
- 8.2 Series prizes will be awarded at the end of the series based on number of entries in each division at the end of the first race day.
- 8.3 The winning boat in each division of three or more entries in the series will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
