1. Rules

- 1.1 The 2021 Cleveland Cup Race is separate from any established CSA series.
- 1.2 The race is governed by the 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (USSA), the rules of the participating classes, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 PHRF-South Shore ratings, rules and rulings apply to all PHRF and JAM rated boats.
- 1.4 A class will have a minimum of 2 boats.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1 The race is also open to all boats in good standing with current PHRF certificates
- 2.2 The entry fee is \$5.00 for CSA Boats in Good standing. Entry fee for Non CSA boats \$20.00
- 2.3 The race will take place on Lake Erie, north of Edgewater Yacht Club.
- 2.4 Register at Clevelandsails.com
- 2.5 Registration for the Cleveland Cup includes Racing, Awards, 2 Discount Grille lunch Tickets per registration and Beer.

- 4.6 The warning signal for the first start will be 1025 hrs

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available on the CSA website (clevelandsails.com) and Regatta network

6. Scoring

- 6.1 The race will be scored using the low point system.

7. Prizes

- 7.1 Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third places for Women's Double-Handed, <30, PHRF, JAM, and One Design classes with 3 or more boats competing.
- 7.2 Prizes will be awarded for first and second places only for classes with 2 or less boats
- 7.3 JAM and PHRF Boat winners will win the Cleveland Cup Trophy.
- 7.4 JAM-Non Racer Class will also be awarded
