

2021 Gold Rush Regatta Notice of Race Grapevine Sailing Club September 17-19, 2021

- 1. The organizing authority is the Grapevine Sailing Club (GSC)
- 2. Site: GSC is a private sailing club, located on the south shore of Lake Grapevine at Scott's Landing Marina. Directions and other information relating to GSC appear at www.grapevinesailing.org
- 3. Rules: This Race shall be governed by:
 - a. The 2021-2024 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (www.ussailing.com/competion),
 - b. Applicable class rules except for any of those that are altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 4. Eligibility:
 - a. GSC Regattas are open to all GSC members and Non-GSC members.
- 5. Entry Fees:
 - a. The Entry Fee for this regatta is \$75.00
 - b. Early online registrants that enter before 2400 (midnight) CDT Friday, September 17th, 2021, will receive a \$10.00 discount.
 - c. Members of US Sailing will receive a \$5.00 discount at any time. Only one US Sailing Member discount allowed per entry.
 - d. To register online, go to the GSC website at www.grapevinesailing.org.
 - e. The Entry Fee Includes:
 - i. Participation in the regatta
 - ii. Participation in the regatta's awards program
 - iii. Complimentary breakfast for skipper & crew on both Saturday and Sunday
 - iv. Complimentary meal for skipper & crew on Sunday before the awards presentation
 - v. Meal tickets for Saturday's dinner will be available for purchase
 - vi. Complimentary beer and beverages at social following racing
 - vii. Use of a ramp for launching and haul out
 - viii. Use of mast hoists for mast stepping
 - ix. Trailer storage/boat dockage for the duration of the regatta
- 6. Fleets and Handicapping
 - a. Handicaps:
 - i. Handicaps for boats will be based on the PHRF handicapping system.
 - ii. Handicap fleets will be formed on the basis of PHRF rating and displacement. Provisional ratings will be given no later than the Skippers Meeting to boats which do not have a current GSC PHRF rating.
 - iii. All declaration shall be made before the end of the Skippers meeting
 - b. Fleet Assignments
 - Boats will be assigned to a fleet by the Vice Commodore and will be announced at the skippers' meeting. Fleet Flags will be announced at the skippers meeting.
 - ii. Three (3) or more one-design boats may sail as a fleet.

0730 - Complimentary Breakfast

1000 - First warning signal Additional races may follow. There are five races scheduled for the regatta

1300 - No start warning signal will be made after 1300 on Sunday.
