

NOTICE OF RACE 2021 Great Pumpkin Regatta October 16-17, 2021 Thistle Fleet 110 Thistle Class Association Birmingham Sailing Club Vincent, AL 35178



- 1. **Rules:** The Regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2. Eligibility and Entry: The Great Pumpkin Regatta is open to boats and competitors meeting the eligibility requirements as described in the (TCA) rules. (All Skippers must be 2021 dues paid TCA members; all boats must be Registered Thistles). Eligible participants must register in advance for the regatta by completing the on-line registration as described in this Notice of Race. To register for the regatta and to purchase meals go to 2021 Great Pumpkin Regatta. The entry fee is \$50.00 or \$45.00 for members of US Sailing.

3. Schedule: (Central Time Zone)

Saturday (October 16) 0930 No onsite registration 1130 Virtual Skipper's Meeting (VHF Channel 68) 1300 Warning Signal for Race 1. Up to 3 races will be held. Sunday (October 17) 0930 Warning Signal for remaining races. No race to start after 1230 CT.

- 4. VHF Radios: The Race Committee may use VHF radios to inform competitors of safety information and to hail boats that are on course side of the starting line (OCS) at the start and general information to assist in the management of the event. No transmissions will be allowed by any competitor while on the water.
- 5. **Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions will be available online at <u>Great Pumpkin</u> <u>Documents</u>. These Sailing Instructions may be modified or amended.
- 6. **Scoring:** A total of 5 races are scheduled and all races sailed will be scored. Boats will be scored in accordance with Appendix A of the RRS as modified by the following statements. One race completed constitutes a regatta.
- 7. **Prizes:** The Great Pumpkin Perpetual Trophy will be presented to the winner and keeper trophies to the top five.
- 8. **Insurance and Damages:** A. The Organizing Committee does not assume any responsibility of any sort regarding the participants and boats. Competitors should have their own insurance covering all risks.
- 9. COVID-19 Policy: We will follow the CDC and state-specific best practices and requirements. This includes frequent hand washing, social distancing, use of face coverings inside, and other guidelines to protect the health and safety of all participants. Each skipper must sign a waiver that their team is COVID symptom free and has not been exposed to anyone with COVID-19.
