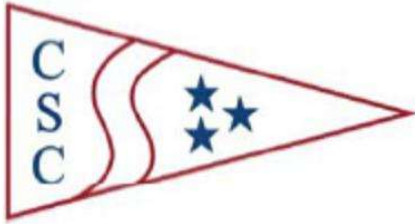

NOTICE OF RACE

Current as of: September 5, 2021

The Chatham Sailing Club Race Committee shares the same passion that all the local racers have for a fun and competitive Regatta. We will be hosting our annual event again this year over the 4th weekend of September out in the Skidaway River/Wassaw Sound. We plan a 2-day regatta with an outdoor banquet on Saturday evening.

Schedule –

- Friday September 24, in-person registration and t-shirt pickup at the Chatham Sailing Clubhouse, Young's Marina from 7-9pm. Also, Skipper's meeting via Zoom to discuss race conditions and planned start location. Zoom link will be emailed to all registrants.
- Saturday September 25, first race start 1100 (11 a.m.), looking to complete 2-3 races by 1700
- Saturday September 25, 6pm – Evening Oktoberfest-themed banquet at Chatham Sailing Clubhouse, Young's Marina.
- Sunday September 26, first race start 1100 (11 a.m.), looking to complete 2-3 races by 1700
- Sunday September 26 – 6pm – Awards and race follow-up at Chatham Sailing Clubhouse, Young's Marina.

The Organizing Authority (OA) of the 2021 Oktoberfest Regatta is the Chatham Sailing Club Race Committee. The OA will have the authority to interpret the conditions governing the event; the right to determine the eligibility of any boat/class/rating; removal for safety violation; final ruling on rule interpretation; make changes when needed.

Safety - Please make sure all boats are safe and adhering to local, state, and Coast Guard regulations. Safety First!

1. Rules - The race will be governed by the current *rules*, as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as modified herein or by the Sailing Instructions.
 - 1.1 Racing rules changed as follows: Rule 42.3(h) if this rule comes into play Rule 42.3(i) can be implemented. This change will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
2. Eligibility and Entry - The regatta is open to all self-righting boats greater than 19'. Registration will be via regattanetwork.com
3. Classification - all boats will be grouped into either Spinnaker (A), Non-Spinnaker (B) or Cruising class (C). If at least 3 J-24s register, there will also be a separate class for them.
4. Fees - Entry fee per boat is \$75, which includes one commemorative t-shirt and one ticket to the dinner. Additional t-shirts and dinner tickets can be paid for in person at the club.
5. Sailing Instructions - The Sailing Instructions will be available after September 20, 2020 on our website chathamsailing.org, and via the regatta network site.
6. Penalty System - Sail a safe, fun, and honest race. If you error, do your turns. If a competitor believes you have erred, do your turns.
7. Scoring – PHRF Time-on-time corrections will apply. Low point scoring system. If at least 5 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout allowed.
8. Radio Communication - must have an operable vhf radio onboard – tune to channel 71.
9. Prizes - prizes will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, and Cruising classes, (and J-24, if enough register).
10. Disclaimer of Liability - Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
11. Insurance - please have some for your sake and the sake of others.
