ADD AND SAVE PROFILES

Modes of Travel

- Select "Modes of Travel"
- Add a mode of travel and provide required information
- Save the profile for future use



Traveler Profile

- Select "Travelers"
- Add a traveler and provide required information
- Save the profile for future use
- Repeat this process for each traveler



Verified Traveler

- Request a number in advance of trip for expedited processing
- CBP will determine and issue eligibility
- I-68, SVRS, LBO and Trusted Traveler numbers accepted in place of Verified Traveler status

DOWNLOAD THE CBP ROAM APP!

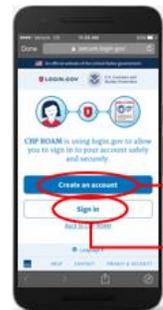
- Search "CBP ROAM" in the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and download the app
- Open the CBP ROAM app and enable location services

SIGN IN TO CBP ROAM VIA LOGIN.GOV

- Click "Log In or Sign Up" and accept the terms. The app will redirect to login.gov, where you can either create or access your existing account
- You must have a login.gov account to use the CBP ROAM app on a personal device



DO NOT HAVE a login.gov account? Tap "Create an Account" and follow the instructions

ALREADY HAVE a login.gov account? Sign in to your account, and you will be redirected back to the CBP ROAM app

CBP ROAM App Benefits

Streamlined reporting process with reusable mode of travel and traveler profiles through login.gov

Shorter wait times by reporting from a smart device, with the option to request a "Verified Traveler" number

Greater convenience with video inspections by CBP officers when applicable

Travelers can use the CBP ROAM app to report their U.S. entry to CBP

- ✓ Accept the terms and sign into CBP ROAM using your login.gov account
- ✓ Select "Create Trip"
- ✓ Select the mode of travel and passengers (saved in profile) on trip. Click "Add Mode of Travel" or "Add Traveler" to add new profiles
- ✓ If traveling by boat, select boat master
- ✓ Answer all trip detail and declaration questions
- ✓ Report your arrival
- ✓ A CBP officer will review your submission and may initiate a video chat if necessary
- ✓ CBP will notify you of your approved entry or next steps. A copy of your entry status will be provided via email
