

Notice of Race

US Windsurf Windfoil National Championship

1. RULES

1.1 The event shall be governed by:

1.2 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)- Windsurf Competition Rules(WCR).

1.3 If there is a conflict between this NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.

1.4 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.2 Classes eligible for entry include IQ Foil, Junior IQ foil, Youth IQ foil, Open Windfoil, and youth Open Windfoil.

2.2 Competitors are eligible for Junior IQ foil fleet if they are under 17 years of age on December 31 2021 and Youth IQ foil fleet if they are under 19 years of age on December 31 2021.

2.3 Youth Open Windfoil divisions will be U19, U17, U15 competitors will be eligible for each respective age group if they are under 19, 17, or 15 years of age on December 31 2021.

3. FEES

3.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$125 USD if received by October 29th

3.2 The entry fee for under 21 competitors will be \$110 USD if received by October 29th

3.3 A late fee of \$15 USD will be added for all entries received after October 29th.

3.3 Late registration will be available onsite November 11th from 1600 to 1900.

3.4 Fee includes racing, two dinners, and a t-shirt.

5. Venue

5.1 Racing will take place in Clearwater Harbor South East of CCSC or in the Gulf of Mexico South of Clearwater pass.

5.2 Competitors will launch from Clearwater Community Sailing Center for racing at either course location.

6. SCORING

6.1 One races is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

6.2 A competitor's series scores will be a total of her race scores excluding her worst scores as follows:

Races completed	#of discards	Comments
1-3	0	No discard
3-7	1	1 worst score discarded
7-12	2	2 worst scores discarded
13 or more	3	3 worst scores discarded

7. PRIZES

7.1 Awards will be given to 1-3 for each division with over 10 boards pre-registered by 10-29-2021. In divisions with less than ten boards pre-registered by 10-29-2021 only first place will be awarded.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
