NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (SMWYC), 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292. (310) 827-7692.

1. Rules:

1.1. The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed herein or by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1. This race is open to One Design, PHRF and Cruising Classes
- 2.2. To be eligible for entry, each boat must:
 - (a) be entered by an individual who is a member of US Sailing or other organization affiliated to US Sailing or to SCYA (or their own National Authority); and
 - (b) have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate;
 - (c) for One Design, must be a member of a One Design Class

3. <u>Entry:</u>

- 3.1. Eligible boats must enter the race online at Regatta Network:
- 3.2. Entries must be received by 1800 on Friday, October 1, 2021.
- 3.3. The entry fee is \$35.00 or \$30.00 for US Sailing Members.

4. Classes:

- 4.1. Classes will be established for One Design, PHRF and Cruising Classes
- 4.2. A minimum of 3 paid entries will be required to establish a class. Entrants of a class that has not met the minimum may be assigned to another appropriate class.
- 4.3. Classes, class flags and the order of starts will be posted online at Regatta Network https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23271 and www.smwyc.org no later than 1800 hours on Friday, October 1, 2021.

5. Schedule:

The scheduled time of the 1st Warning Signal is 1155. For PHRF and One-Design classes three races are scheduled. For the Cruising classes two races are scheduled.

6. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be ava<u>il</u>able online at <u>www.smwyc.org</u>, posted on the Regatta Network event website page https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23271 and at the front desk of SMWYC no later than 1800 hours on Friday, October 1, 2021

7. The Courses:

Courses will be set using marks on Course Chart 17.

8. Scoring:

- 8.1 All race scores will count. This changes RRS A2.1
- 8.2 PHRF Classes will use So Cal PHRF Area B Ratings.
- 8.3 Scoring for PHRF classes will be calculated using the time on distance method.
- 8.4 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

9. Radio Communication:

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio channel 71.

10. Awards and post racing:

Awards will be given in each class. Trophies will be presented at SMWYC after racing. All entrants are encouraged to dress in *Oktoberfest* themed attire on or off the water. Best dressed attendees will awarded.

11. Pre-race kick off party:

Please attend our pre-regatta kick off party on Friday October 1st at 6pm. This regatta is our last of the season and we want to finish this 'comeback year' with a bang!
