NOTICE OF RACE

Fleet 48 invites you to the annual Fall 48 located on Beautiful Lake Norman, North Carolina's largest manmade lake.

Please join us for our annual Fall 48 regatta. We've made some great renovations to the clubhouse and even added a new patio and firepit that should be perfect for this time of year. We'll have chili on Friday night for the early arrivals and chicken on Saturday night. Camping is free on the grounds and there are showers available at the clubhouse and the pavilion. All registration will be handled via Regatta Network. Please note there will be NO onsite registration for this event nor the need to check in onshore prior to this event. Please make sure that you register online with your correct sail number and email address. Please provide a phone number for text messages.

The notation [DP] in a *rule* means that the penalty for a breach of the *rule* may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

The notation [NP] in a *rule* mean that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that *rule*. This changes rule 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. This Regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing, with the following changes:
 - 1.1.1. US Sailing prescriptions to rules 63.2 and 63.4b shall not apply.
 - 1.1.2. Appendix V, Alternative Penalties V1 and V2 will be in effect.
 - 1.1.3. Rules 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10 are amended to add: "Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes of the first boat to finish and not subsequently retiring, penalized or given redress will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing and scored for the finishing place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within her Finishing Window
 - 1.1.4. Appendices A5.1 and A5.2 are amended to add: "A boat that has not met the definition of *start* 5 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Flying Scots
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering online at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23273>
- 2.3. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

3. REGISTRATION FEES

- 3.1. Registration is \$45 per boat
- 3.2. Payment must be received by November 1st to avoid a late fee of \$15.
- 3.3. All registrations must be paid on-line.

Courses will be windward-leeward.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A.
- 9.2. A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta.
- 9.3. There is no limit on the number of races.

10. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the top five boats.
