1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International 505 Class.
- 2.2 Any sailor who has recently shown symptoms, is awaiting results, or actively shows symptoms of Covid-19 is not permitted to compete.

3 ENTRY

- 3.1 Registration **must** be completed on the regatta's webpage (link below). It is highly recommended to complete the registration and payment before coming to the event.

- 4.1 Fees must be paid online prior to the close of registration. Cash and checks will not be accepted.

- 9.5 Awards to follow after racing at an outdoor, socially distant, masks required gathering.
- 9.6 Number of Races:
There is no limit to the number of races. The RC will attempt to maximize racing for the conditions available.
