### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

1.1 Rules will be detailed in the SI's.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is N/A for this regatta.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all members of Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations recognized by US Sailing, and those that have read and will follow the rules according to the **“SAFE REOPENING PROTOCOL RECREATIONAL BOATING (NON-COMMERCIAL) ADDENDUM”**:

Only members of one of the South Bay Yacht Clubs (Coronado YC, Coronado Cays YC, or Navy San Diego YC) can qualify for the championship regatta.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network.

3.3 All entries must be submitted by the day of the race by 9 am.

3.4 No Late entries will be accepted.

#### 4 CLASSIFICATION

Classes are noted in the SI's.

#### 5 FEES

5.1 Fees for each race are determined by the hosting regatta (no more than \$30).

#### 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be posted on regatta network and available at the host Club by 10am of the race day.

#### 7 VENUE and DATES

- 7.1 This course will be located in the South Bay.
- 7.2 The SBC regatta is 3 qualifying regatta's hosted by each yacht club and a championship regatta hosted by the winner of record. In order to qualify for the championship regatta a boat must have completed a race in one of the qualifying regattas.
- 7.3 SBC Winter – Hosted by Coronado Yacht Club [February 20, 2021].  
SBC Summer – Hosted by Navy Yacht Club [July 17, 2021].  
SBC Fall – Hosted by the Coronado Cays Yacht Club [ September 5, 2021].  
SBC Championship – Hosted by the Coronado Cays Yacht Club [October 10, 2021].
