# **NOTICE OF RACE**

October 16 and 17th **2021** 

Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Melbourne Yacht Club (MelbourneYachtClub.com).

Rules: This regatta is governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

**Expected Classes:** Sunfish, Laser, Portsmouth, Collegiate 420 and A-Class Cat. The Portsmouth Division will use the DP-N number listed on the US Sailing web with adjustments at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

**Entry and Eligibility:** This Regatta is open to the listed One-Design Classes and monohull boats ≤ 20 ft LOA. Five or more paid entries in a class type (other than those listed above) are required to have a one design Division prior to end of registration Saturday. Completion of the entry form and liability waver is required in order to compete. The entry fee is \$35 per boat. You must enter on Regatta Networks ( regattanetorwks.com )

Sailing Area: The Indian River Lagoon, south of the Melbourne causeway.

**Food:** On Saturday and Sunday MYC will have \$1 hot dogs available to purchase immediately after sailing. Water and sodas will be provided. Adult beverages will be available for purchase in the bar.
