Notice of Race (NoR)

ABBREVIATIONS

[NP] Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by:
 - a) The Rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix E,
 - b) DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules,
- 1.2 **[NP]** All applicable governmental regulations regarding health, safety and infectious disease control shall be strictly followed by all competitors.
- 1.3 **[NP]** Competitors using any Chicago Yacht Club facilities, including docks, shall follow <u>House and</u> *Ground Rules In Effect Due to Covid-19*.
- 1.4 Violations of Section 1.2 and 1.3 of this Notice of Race shall not be protestable by a competitor but may be protested by the Race Committee or Organizing Authority (OA). *This changes RRS* 60.1.
- 1.5 A boat that may have broken rule 31 while racing does not have to take any penalty turns and violations are not protestable by competitors. Rule 31 is still in effect. *This changes RRS E4.3* and 60.1.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to DragonForce 65 remote controlled sailboats only.
 - a) The use of A-Plus rigs is prohibited.
- 2.2 An eligible boat may enter by submitting the online entry form together with the appropriate fee, available at: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23332.
- 2.3 All boats must be properly registered online in order to compete.
- 2.4 Registered competitor must be the skipper of his/her boat.

3 FEES

The entry fee is \$20.00 for the series.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Races will be held on 10/2/21, 10/9/21, 10/16/21, 10/23/21, 10/30/21, and 11/6/21 at Belmont Station.
- 4.2 Onsite check-in will take place starting 30 minutes prior to the first start.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning of the first race is 1430 hours.
- 4.4 It is the intention of the Race Committee to run up ten (10) races each day.



5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1700 on September 29, 2021 and will be posted online.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Belmont Harbor near Chicago Yacht Club - Belmont Station.

7 COACHING

- 7.1 Chicago Yacht Club may provide on the water coaching during the racing. *This changes rule 41.*
- 7.2 A competitor shall not seek redress for failure to receive specific coaching instructions or as the result of the consequences of a particular coaching instruction. *This changes rule* 62.1(a).

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Nine (9) races will constitute a series.
- 8.2 Once a series has been completed, each boat may exclude her worst scores, one (1) race for every six (6) sailed, for the entire series.
- The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) score shall be the number of boats checked-in plus two (2) for that day of racing. *This changes RRS A5.3.*

9 PRIZES

Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall.
