### Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

*A fun and easy race for DRYC member skippers and their crews,  
to race their boats!*

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2, and RRS 81 will not apply.
- 1.3 The head of any spinnaker must be below the lowest spreader, when the bow crosses an extension of the detached breakwater.
- 1.4 When entering the clubhouse: all guests and members must present proof of vaccination to the front desk and wear a name tag. Except while actively eating or drinking, masks are required.

#### 2 COMMUNICATION

- 2.1 The official online notice board is located at [dryc.org](http://dryc.org), under the racing tab.
- 2.2 While on the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make oral changes and broadcast information on VHF channel 68.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY, FEES, DIVISIONS, and CLASSES

- 3.1 This is an intraclub event, requiring that each skipper be a member of DRYC.
- 3.2 There is no entry fee. The entry deadline is 1200 November 20, 2021. Enter at [dryc.org](http://dryc.org), under the racing tab.
- 3.3 There will be 2 divisions, PHRF and Cruising. Valid PHRF membership IS NOT required
- 3.4 Any entry unsuitable for the Cruising Division may be moved to the PHRF Division.
- 3.5 The class splits and flags will be posted by 1800 November 20, 2021.

#### **4 SCHEDULE AND COURSES**

- 4.1 The course chart will be posted by 1800 November 20th, 2021.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155, with multiple sound signals approximately 1minute before.
- 4.3 From the starting line, sail the course signaled by the RC (code flag A, B or C).
- 4.4 Return to the marina through the South Entrance. The line connecting the “No Sail” buoys on the north side of the channel shall not be crossed
- 4.5 Proceed to the finishing line, main channel center markers can be ignored.

#### **5 THE START**

The starting line will between an orange flag on the RC boat and SS Mark.

#### **6 THE FINISH**

- 6.1 The finishing line will be between an orange flag on a boat slipped in DRYC’s main channel dock and an orange flag or marker in the water, adjacent to the DRYC docks.
- 6.2 Boats not finishing by 1600 will be scored DNF without a hearing (this changes RRS 35 and A5).

#### **7 HANDICAP RATINGS / SCORING**

PHRF of So. California Area B RLC ratings shall apply, unrated boats will be assigned one.

#### **8 HEARING REQUESTS**

- 8.1 A boat intending to file a protest shall orally inform the RC when they finish.
- 8.2 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the protesting boat finishes (protest time limit).
- 8.3 Protests shall be filed at the DRYC front desk, hearings may be scheduledat a later date.
