1. RULES

- 1.1 The event shall be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The class rules of the participating classes will apply as amended by the sailing instructions.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.
- 1.5 Competitors will follow CCSC Covid-19 guidelines.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

Classes eligible for entry include Optimist Green

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$40 if received by October 22nd.
- 4.2 After 23:59 October 22nd a \$5 late fee will be added.
- 4.3 Fee covers racing and awards. No food will be given out by the organizing authority.

6. MEASUREMENT

It is the responsibility of each competitor that his/her equipment conforms to the IODA class rules.

7. VENUE

Green Fleet racing will be held in Clearwater Harbor East of Clearwater Community Sailing Center.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Awards

Awards will be distributed to the top 5 green fleet sailors.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

11. Safety
11.1 A US Coast Guard approved PFD shall be worn by all competitors and coaches.
11.2 All support boat helmsman shall wear a kill cord at all times while operating their vessel. Violation of this may be grounds for
expulsion from the event.
