NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*(RRS).
- 1.2 All boats shall comply with their respective class rules.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website approximately one week prior to race day and in the clubhouse on race day.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Penguin and Comet class boats.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (<u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0930 on Saturday, November 6. Online registration is required.
- 3.3 Races may be cancelled for a class if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Thursday,November4.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$35 for CBYRA or USSA members, \$45 for non-members, to be received no later than 0930 on Saturday, November 6.
- 4.2 Bag lunches available for advance purchase. See pricing on Regatta Network at the time of registration. Advance purchase only.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 0830-0930 Free continental breakfast
- 5.2 0945 Competitors' Meeting
- 5.3 1045 Warning signal for first class
- 5.4 As many races as possible will be sailed, but no race will start after 1430.

6 THE VENUE

6.1 Races will be sailed in the Tred Avon River using drop marks. Exact location to be announced by PRO at Competitors' Meeting.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 A boat's regatta score shall be the total of all her race scores unless five or more races have been completed, in which case her worst score will be excluded, subject to Rule 90.3(b).
- 7.2 At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 register, 2 if 5 register, 3 if 7 or more register.
- 8.2 Prizes will be presented on the first floor of the TAYC clubhouse as soon as possible after the conclusion of racing.
- 8.3 Results will be posted at <u>www.tayc.com/racing.</u>

9 SPECIAL COVID-19 REGATTA RULES

9.1 Current state and local requirements for protection against the transmission of Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta. Masks and social distancing are recommended for those who have not been fully vaccinated.
