### **COVID-19 STATEMENT**

**Covid-19:** Per recommendations of the CDC, State of Georgia, US Sailing, SAYRA (South Atlantic Yacht Racing Association), and ASC (Augusta Sailing Club), specific Covid-19 protocols will be followed. The safety of our members and staff are the driving force for modifications to this event. Single-handed sailing or family sailing is recommended during this pandemic. All members and guests are encouraged to wear facemasks, especially if unable to socially distance by 6 feet or more. The safety and health of each member is the responsibility of the individual. Participation in this event comes with inherent risks due to the nature of the sport, as well as the pandemic. By participating and registering in the regatta and/or meals, members acknowledge and understand these risks. We will monitor the situation daily and make appropriate changes as needed. Any changes will be posted on the website registration page. Please note there will be no on-site registrations. Our scoring committee will be safely working remotely from home. Competitors will not need to check-in for this event, so please make sure that you register online with your correct sail number.

The organizing authority is the Augusta Sailing Club at Strom Thurmond Lake at Clarks Hill.

**Rules:** Racing is governed by the rules defined by US Sailing: The 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, individual class rules, ASC PHRF rules and Sailing Instructions (SI Available on-line), and as modified by the Notice of Race.

**Classes:** Racing is open to PHRF boats with a current Augusta Sailing Club PHRF Certificate. **Laser (Radials and Fulls) will also be included in the Hangover Regatta.**

**Scoring:** PHRF scoring of each race will be based on corrected times. Corrected times will be calculated using the "Time-on-Time" method. For the Series, each day will be scored as a one-day mini-regatta, with the series

scores being based on the combination of the one-day scores, as described in the Sailing Instructions.

**Fees:** Entry fee for the series is \$50 per boat. Registration for any single race day is \$10 per boat. Single Day registrations will not be scored in the series. Registration for the series includes entry into the Hangover Regatta (1/1/22). All other registrants must register for the Hangover Regatta separately. Hangover Regatta registration is \$25 per boat.

**Registration:** Registration and payment will be online only. There will be no on-site registration. Boats must register before **10:00AM on Saturday of their first race**. Boats not registered will not be scored.

**Schedule:** Race schedule is as follows: 10/23/2021, 11/6/2021, 11/20/2021, 12/4/2021, 12/18/2021, and 1/1/2022 (Hangover Regatta). The Hangover Regatta will count as the last day of Fall Series and separately as a one day regatta. A competitors meeting will be held outside the clubhouse on October 23, 2021 at 10:00 AM, as well as on January 1, 2022 (Hangover Regatta). The starting sequence will begin at 12:00 noon on each day.

**Courses:** Courses will be described at the competitors meeting and posted on the committee boat.

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers for each fleet having three or more boats.
