SUPPLEMENT to the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

(Numbering corresponds to the RRS Appendix S)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule of the sailing instructions (SSIs) means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

3 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRCUTIONS

3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect. Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole located on the front lawn of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron. This changes RRS S 4.1.
- 4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with not less than 60 minutes' in the race signal AP.

7. THE COURSES

- 7.3 For the one design classes, courses will be either TL, LA, WA, LAD or TAD. The supplement describes course LAD and TAD, the order in which the marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 7.4 For the PHRF classes, courses shall be selected from Sarasota Sailing Squadron compass rose marks lettered A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L or M or government marks IC 13, IC 15, IC 16, IC 17, ICNP, NP19 or MJ-3. The course numbers/letter will be posted on the R/C Signal Boat in the order of passing, the first number being the first mark to be passed. All marks shall be kept to **PORT**. The last number posted indicates the finishing mark.

8 MARKS

8.2 One Design course

Mark	Description
1, 2s, 2p	Orange Tetrahedron
1a	Small orange buoy
Start	Green Tetrahedron
Finish	Small white buoy
Change Mark	Yellow Tetrahedron
3	Orange Tetrahedron

- 8.3 If either mark 1 or 1a is missing the single mark will be rounded to port.
- 8.4 If one of the gate marks (2s/2p) is missing, the remaining mark will be left to port.

9 THE START

- 9.3 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.
- 9.4. The Race Committee may announce the sail number or boat name of each premature starter on the applicable VHF channel. Failure to make an announcement or the order in which boats are announced shall not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1(a).

10 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

10.2 In the event of a change of course that relocates mark 1, mark 1a will not be relocated.

12 TIME LIMITS

12.5 Failure to meet target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).


13 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 13.2 The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the signal boat docks. This changes RRS S 13.2.
- 13.5 Protest hearings are expected to be heard in person but may be changed to online. Instructions for online hearings will be provided by the Jury.


15 [DP][NP]SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 15.1 Boats shall check in with the race committee prior to their first race of the day by sailing past the transom of the committee boat.
- 15.2 Boats shall advise the race committee if leaving the race area prior to the end of the last day of the day.







