

Amazing Grace Cheney Cup 2021 – Notice of Race

Race date: Sunday, November 7, 2021

Organizing Authority: Richmond Yacht Club, Point Richmond, California

1 RULES and more rules...

1.1 This regatta will be sailed in compliance with the most recent Contra Costa County Covid19 Health Order and RYC Protocols. Subsequent Health Orders related to Covid-19 may result in revisions to the Sailing Instructions, up to, and including cancellation and refund of registration fees. All competitors are required to abide by the state and local laws, guidelines and recommendations, as well as host club's restrictions with regard to the COVID-19 virus. Per the RYC Board of Directors, skippers and crew members will be required to show proof of vaccination (vaccination card or a picture of the vaccination card) when checking in. Boats with a skipper or crew who is not vaccinated/doesn't show proof of vaccination can still race, but unvaccinated people are asked to stay off the RYC property during the regatta and to check in on Friday prior to the start of the regatta.

1.2 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all sailors. Only the driver must be female. Yacht Club membership is not required. Boats must have a PHRF certificate.

2.2 Eligible boats can be entered by completing online registration at www.richmondyc.org
Entry fee is \$1.00/ per foot

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1 Sunday, November 7, 2021- first start will be at 1200 Hours (note that with pursuit course start times will be different depending on what course will be sailed.)

One race is scheduled.

7. ARBITRATION

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to first thru fifth plus other awards, and the plan is on the water awards so stick around if you are in the first 5 boats.
