## **Notice of Race (NoR)**

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**[NP]** Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. ***This changes RRS 60.1(a).***

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by:
  - a) The Rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix E,
  - b) [DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules](#),
- 1.2 **[NP]** All applicable governmental regulations regarding health, safety and infectious disease control shall be strictly followed by all competitors.
- 1.3 **[NP]** Competitors using any Chicago Yacht Club facilities, including docks, shall follow [House and Ground Rules In Effect Due to Covid-19](#).
- 1.4 A boat that may have broken rule 31 while racing does not have to take any penalty turns and violations are not protestable by competitors. Rule 31 is still in effect. ***This changes RRS E4.3 and 60.1.***
- 1.5 **[DP]** Any competitor or support person who leaves the shore in a boat during this series shall wear a personal flotation device and have a cellular phone or VHF device with them. Failure to do so will result in a score of DNE for all races that day without a hearing. ***This changes rule 63.1.***

### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The series is open to DragonForce 65 remote controlled sailboats only.
- 2.2 There will be two fleets of DF65 boats.
  - a) Gold Fleet
  - b) Silver Fleet – A+ rigs are prohibited – ***This changes Class Rule Section E.***
- 2.2 An eligible boat may enter by submitting the online entry form together with the appropriate fee, available at: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23522>.
- 2.3 All boats must be properly registered online in order to compete.
- 2.4 Registered competitor must be the skipper of his/her boat.

### **3 FEES**

The entry fee is \$35.00 for the series.

### **4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Races will be held on 12/11/21, 1/8/22, 1/22/22, 2/5/22, 2/12/22, 3/5/22 at Monroe Station.
- 4.2 Onsite check-in will take place starting 30 minutes prior to the first start.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning of the first race is 1400 hours.



- 4.4 It is the intention of the Race Committee to run up ten (10) races each day for each fleet.  
4.5 Each fleet will have their own start. Rotations between the fleets will be announced by RC on the day of racing.

## 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1700 on December 10, 2021 and will be posted online.

## 6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Monroe Harbor near Chicago Yacht Club - Monroe Station.

## 7 COACHING

- 7.1 Chicago Yacht Club may provide on the water coaching during the racing. ***This changes rule 41.***  
7.2 A competitor shall not seek redress for failure to receive specific coaching instructions or as the result of the consequences of a particular coaching instruction. ***This changes rule 62.1(a).***

## 8 SCORING

- 8.1 Nine (9) races will constitute a series.  
8.2 Once a series has been completed, each boat may exclude her worst scores, one (1) race for every six (6) sailed, for the entire series.  
8.3 The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) score shall be the number of boats checked-in plus one (1) for that day of racing. ***This changes RRS A5.3.***

## 9 PRIZES

Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall for each fleet.
