Safety Boats and Resources on the Water

Clear Lake Channel

The Clear Lake Channel is approximately a 15 minute tow from Clear Lake to the bay on an average day. Construction activity and boater traffic require vigilance from sailors and coaches. RIBs for towing will be available on race days.

Medical Emergencies On the Water

Emergency Response Pick-Up Location:

Blue Marlin Fuel Dock

Severe life threatening injury:

For example: head injury with loss of consciousness, severe bleeding, drowning or if any doubt.

- Call 911
- Hail Race Committee on VHF
- Proceed to EMS ambulance pick-up location
- Notify on-shore safety and contacts

Severe non-life threatening injuries:

For example: severe cuts, broken bones, head injuries when the victim is conscious.

- Hail Race Committee on VHF
- If it is safe to do so, transfer the victim to the first-aid boat or the fastest available boat for transport
- Proceed to Lakewood Yacht Club on-shore First Aid station
- Notify on-shore safety and contacts
