- 1 **Organizing Authority/Jurisdiction:** Corinthian Sailing Association
- 2 **Host Club:** New Orleans Yacht Club, 403 N Roadway Dr, New Orleans, LA 70124
- 3 **Race Committee:** Corinthian Sailing Association and New Orleans Yacht Club

- 4 **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the US Sailing Prescriptions (sailing.org/racingrules/documents) and the Corinthian Sailing Association Sailing Instructions

- 5 **Eligibility:** Open but not limited to the following fleets and classes: PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, Boats with an X or S designation on the PHRF Certificate, and Multihull. Divisions may be broken into smaller Classes. Three (3) or more boats properly registered, checked in and on the starting line will constitute a fleet or class.

- 6 **Entry Fee:** Standard entry – registration November 27 – December 3: \$55
Corinthian Sailing Association Member – half price
Registration by November 26 – \$10 discount
US Sailing discount – \$5 discount

Competitors are urged to register early so that the Race Committee can assign accurate class breaks. No entries will be accepted after the conclusion of the Skipper's Meeting.

- 8 **Sailing Instructions / Official Notice Board** The Sailing Instructions will be posted online and made available prior to the Skipper's Meeting. The Official Notice Board is located at NOYC's Bar Area.

- 9 **Disclaimer of Liability** Refer to RRS 1.2; 3 and 4. In addition, the skipper, boat owner, and each crew member are responsible for his/her own safety, and for the seaworthiness of his/her boat. It shall be the sole responsibility of the skipper, boat owner and each crew member to determine if they want to participate in this regatta and what actions they take to ensure their safety, to prevent injury, loss of life and material injury prior to, during, or after the regatta.

- 10 **Scoring** The Pursuit Start will be based upon PHRF rating and used to determine winners in each class. ORR scoring will be determined for yachts with an ORR certificate. If a yacht has an ORR certificate, she will be eligible for the ORR trophy for 1st place in that division.

- 11 **Prizes** Overall 1st, 2nd & 3rd place trophies will be awarded for each class. Trophies will be awarded at the Host Club after the last race and protest hearings, if any.

- 12 **Racing Area** The racing area is starting and finishing near the south shore of Lake Pontchartrain - NOAA Chart 11369
