NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing,* this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all keelboats, all Clubs.
- 2.2 Classes will be: Handicap Non-Spinnaker and Handicap Spinnaker.
- 2.3 Competitors to have either a PHRF-GB certificate or a HYC club rating assigned by the Race Committee. (Note: this is a FUN regatta providing an opportunity for friendly competition and sailing to celebrate the New Year)
- 2.4 Competitors may enter the event by registering online at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23561 or at the Competitor's briefing. Online entry deadline is Saturday January 1, 2022 at 10:00 am.

3. FEES

3.1 There is no entry fee.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 January 1, 2022:

12:00 Noon - Competitor's briefing in the HYC bar.

1:30 p.m. (approximately, TBA at Competitor's briefing) - Start Time.

4:00 p.m. (approximately) - Awards in the HYC bar. Black-eyed peas and cornbread will be served.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be distributed at the Competitor's Briefing and available on Regatta Network no later than December 25, 2021.
- 5.2 Boat Start time table will be distributed at the Competitor's Briefing.

6. VENUE

6.1 All races will be sailed in the vicinity of the Houston Yacht Club in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by Morgan's Point on the North, the Bayport Ship Channel on the south, the Houston Ship Channel on the East, and the La Porte/Shoreacres shoreline.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 Both classes will race windward-leeward pursuit style course as identified in the sailing instructions

8. SCORING

8.1 One race is scheduled. Finish position is based on the order of finish, i.e., pursuit style race.

9. BERTHING

9.1 Contact the HYC Harbormanager on VHF Radio Channel 68 or 281-471-1255 for temporary slip assignment for the Regatta.

10. PRIZES

10.1 Trophies are, as of yet, undetermined - but certain to be of a highly desirable nature.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 3, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
