#### NOTICE OF RACE

#### ORGANIZING AUTHORITY AND RACE MANAGEMENT

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta is the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA). The Dana Point Yacht Club (DPYC) Race Committee (RC) will manage this regatta and shall appoint a Protest Committee (PC).

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to Rule 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.3 The <u>US Safety Equipment Requirements</u> (SER) Near Shore Category will apply, except as modified by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 The rules of PHRF of Southern California (PHRF) will apply.
- 1.5 **[DP]** RRS 64.2, Penalties is modified by adding: (c) When the protest committee decides a boat that is a party to a protest hearing has broken a rule, it may assign a time penalty to be added to the boat's corrected time.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to boats in PHRF Spinnaker and RS Tera classes.
- 2.2 PHRF class entries must have a valid current PHRF rating certificate.
- 2.3 To become an entrant in the regatta skippers must complete an Online Entry Form and pay all fees by the entry deadline of 1800 hours, Friday, February 18, 2022.

#### 3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board on the Regatta Network website no later than February 17, 2022.
- 3.2 A race packet including the Sailing Instructions and additional information will be issued to each boat at their respective Skipper's Meeting as stated in NOR 5 below.
- 3.3 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions after Friday, February 18, 2022 will only be posted on the Secondary Regatta Notice Board located in the Horizon Bar area upstairs at DPYC by 1030 hours of the day they are to take effect.

#### 4. FEES

#### 5. COMPETITOR'S MEETING

- 5.1 Competitor's meetings are scheduled as follows:
- 5.1.1 Saturday, February 19, 2022 at 0900 hours for PHRF Classes
- 5.1.2 Sunday, February 20, 2022 at 0900 hours for the RS Tera Class.

#### 6. CLASSES

- 6.1 PHRF Classes will be based upon the type and number of entries received using their PHRF Area E ratings. Any boat from outside Area E where there is no like Area E rated boat will be based upon their PHRF Regional ratings.
- 6.2 Anticipated classes are PHRF A, PHRF B, PHRF C.
- 6.3 RS Tera will include both Sport and Pro Classes.
- 6.4 The RC retains final authority for a boat's class placement.

#### 7. SCHEDULE

7.1 Dana Point Yacht Club 24399 Dana Drive, Dana Point, CA 92629 (Map)

#### Saturday, February 19, 2022

0900 – Competitor's meeting, PHRF Classes 1155 – 1<sup>st</sup> Warning Signal, PHRF Classes Post-Race festivities following racing

#### Sunday, February 20, 2022

0800 – Check-in RS Tera Classes 0900 – Competitor's meeting, RS Tera Classes 1130 – 1<sup>st</sup> Warning Signal, RS Tera Classes

1155 – 1<sup>st</sup> Warning Signal, PHRF Classes Trophy Presentations following racing.

#### 7.2 **PHRF Classes** are scheduled as follows:

- 7.2.1 There are four (4) races scheduled.
- 7.2.2 The Race Committee will attempt to run three (3) Windward/Leeward races on Saturday and one (1) Random Leg race on Sunday.
- 7.2.3 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race each day is 1155 hours.

- 7.3 **RS Tera Classes** are scheduled as follows:
- 7.3.1 There are five (5) races scheduled on Sunday only.
- 7.3.2 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race is 1130 hours.

#### 8. COMMUNICATION

- 8.1 The Official Regatta Notice Board is located on the Regatta Network website.
- 8.2 The Secondary Regatta Notice Board located in the Horizon Bar area upstairs at DPYC.
- 8.3 On the water, the RC may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors by VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 8.4 **[DP]** From the first warning signal until the end of each race, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

#### 9. VENUE

9.1 NOR Addendum A shows the location of the event venue and the racing area.

#### 10. COURSES AND RACE AREA

- 10.1 The general race area for this regatta will be as shown on NOR Addendum A and on Dana Point Race Chart v.8.0.
- 10.2 Sunday only, there will be two separate starting areas. One for PHRF Classes and one for RS Tera Classes.
- 10.3 The courses for PHRF Classes will be selected from a Buoy Race Chart Supplement for windward-leeward races and the Dana Point Race Chart v.8.0 for the Random Leg race. Both will be included in their Sailing Instructions.
- 10.4 The courses for RS Tera Classes will be selected from a course chart which will be provided to all racers at the Competitor's Meeting.

#### 11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply. A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2.
- 11.2 Boats shall be scored using PHRF Area E ratings.
- 11.3 Any boat from outside Area E where there is no like Area E rated boat will be scored using their PHRF Regional ratings.
- 11.4 At least two (2) races must be completed to constitute the Regatta.

#### 12. PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 US Sailing Prescriptions Appendix V will apply.

#### 13. RISK STATEMENT

13.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage, injury and death. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race.

#### 14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 The race organizers (OA, RC, PC, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

#### 15. AWARDS CELEBRATION

- 15.1 Post-Race festivities following racing both days will take place at Dana Point Yacht Club.
- 15.2 Results will be posted each day at DPYC. Final results will be announced following racing and resolution of all protests on Sunday.
- 15.3 SCYA Trophies will be awarded on Sunday according to the following schedule:

15.4 Trophies not claimed within 30 days shall be forfeited.
