**NOTICE OF RACE**

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY AND RACE MANAGEMENT**

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta is the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA). The Dana West Yacht Club Race Committee (RC) will manage this regatta and shall appoint a Protest Committee.

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The [Racing Rules of Sailing](#)*, except [US Sailing Prescriptions](#) to Rule 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.2 The Rules of PHRF of Southern California will apply. <https://phrfsocal.org/>

**2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES**

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the Regatta Network website on or before race day.
- 2.2 DWYC will host a Skipper's meeting Saturday February 12<sup>th</sup> at 09:00.

**3 COMMUNICATIONS**

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at DWYC and on the Regatta Network website.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.3 When the first warning signal sounds non-emergency voice and data communication is prohibited.

#### **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the non-spinnaker class(es)
- 4.2 All eligible boats must enter on-line no later than Saturday February 12, 2022 08:00.
- 4.3 Boats may enter the event by registering online at:

- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.5 All boats shall have clearly visible sail numbers. Missing, improper, inconsistent, unclear, illegible, or numbers other than those used for check-in, are not permitted and may result in being scored DNF. RRS 60.2, 63.1, and A5 are modified to add that the RC may disqualify a boat infringing this instruction without a hearing.

#### **5 FEES**

- 5.2 A portion of the fees are used to help offset the costs SCYA provides to the yachting community.

#### **6 CLASSES AND CLASS PENNANTS**

- 6.1 The following classes will be offered: A & B classes will be determined by number of entries prior to or on race day at the discretion of DWYC race committee.
- 6.2 The class numeral pennant must be flown from the backstay of all yachts, or in a prominent manner on the stern, when checking in, while racing, and when finishing. Competitors shall supply their own numeral pennant.
- 6.5 The Organizing Authority retains final authority for a boat's class placement.

#### **7 SCHEDULE**

- 7.1 Registration must be completed by February 12, 2022 08:00.
- 7.2 3 races are scheduled for all classes. 2 races must be completed.
- 7.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 11:25. The warning signal for the subsequent races will be as soon as possible after the completion of the previous race.
- 7.5 There is a time limit of 35 MINUTES for all racing.

#### **8 VENUE**

- 8.1 The racing area will be outside Dana Point Harbor.
- 8.2 The starting area will be .8 MILES SE of the Dana Point Harbor entrance.

#### **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 9.1 US Sailing Prescriptions Appendix V will apply.

#### **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 10.2 Each boat's score shall be determined using PHRF Area E ratings.
- 10.3 Boats will be scored using Time-on-Course. The total score will be determined by the sum of all races.

## 11 AWARDS CELEBRATION

- 11.1 After race events will occur at DWYC immediately following the final race.
- 11.2 SCYA trophies will be awarded following the final race. Prizes will be awarded based on the number of participants at the discretion of the DWYC race committee.
- 11.3 Music and dancing to follow trophy presentation and hospitality is extended to all racers.

## 12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. The race organizers DWYC & SCYA, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or another organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. As a condition of their participation in this regatta, competitors release all claims they may have against DWYC or SCYA and its officers, directors, members, committees and employees for damage to property, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Competitors shall be responsible for damage or injury caused by their breach of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* or applicable governmental rules for the avoidance of collision.

## 13 INSURANCE

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
