Notice of Race

March 4 – 6, 2022

Organizing Authority: Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS)

1. Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Sailing Instructions

2.1 Sailing Instructions will be available online after 1700 on March 3, 2022 at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23598>

3. Communication

3.1 The online official notice board is located at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23598>

3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel -TBA

3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the sailing instructions (SIs).

3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The event is open to all one-design multihull boats or multihull boats with holding a valid Portsmouth or PHRF certificate.

4.2 A minimum of 5 boats makes a class. Expected classes include Corsair, Farrier, Stiletto, Windriders and a variety of other multihulls.

4.3 The organizing authority reserves the right to group similar boats together to form one or more open classes.

4.4 Eligible boats may only enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee to <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23598>

4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5. Fees

5.1 Entry fees (including a shirt and hat) are as follows:

6. Schedule



6.1 Dates of Racing:

Date	Warning Signal
Friday, March 4, 2022	1130 hrs
Saturday, March 5, 2022 (3-day racers)	1000 hrs
Saturday, March 5, 2022 (2-day racers)	1125 hrs
Sunday, March 6, 2022	1000 hrs

6.2 A maximum of 12 races are scheduled.

6.3 On the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

7. Equipment Inspection

- 7.1 Each boat not having a one design rating shall supply a valid rating to the organizing authority by 1900hrs on March 3, 2022.
- 7.2. If a valid rating is not available, a temporary rating will be assigned (on a best-efforts basis) for the duration of this regatta at the discretion of the organizing authority.

8. Venue

- 8.1 Racing will take place in Sarasota Bay.

9. The Courses

- 9.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward.

10. Penalty System

- 10.1 For all classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-turn Penalty.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 Race results will be calculated using the Time on Time scoring method.
- 11.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When 5 – 11 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
(c) When 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. Risk Statement

12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.



12.2 Competitors voluntarily assume the risks associated with communicable diseases including but not limited to COVID-19.

13. Insurance

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

14. Prizes

- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class for classes with five or more boats entered.
- 14.2 The Organizing Authority, may at its discretion, award Corinthian trophies for boats whose crew has only Group 1 competitors as described in WS Regulation 22 (Sailor Classification Code).
- 14.3 The winners of the Stiletto Class will be awarded the title "2022 Stiletto National Champions".
- 14.4 Additional awards may be presented.
