## **CONDITIONS OF THIS PERMIT**

- Feeding and harassing wildlife is illegal. Never leave food unattended and store food securely.
- Fires are permitted only in established fire grates at picnic areas and campsites. The use of self-contained barbecues (gas and charcoal) is permitted as long as they are attended at all times and extinguished prior to departure. Portable fire pits and chimeneas are prohibited.
- Electric or amplified instruments and/or public address systems are limited. Recorded music
  may be played as long as the volume is such that it does not disturb other park visitors in the
  area. Instruments are allowed as long as the volume is such that it does not disturb other park
  visitors in the area. Per 36 CFR sound cannot exceed 85db at any time as measured at 50 ft.
  from A-weighted scale. No amplification or public address systems are allowed from 10:00 PM
  until 6:00 AM.
- Generators used must be "whisper" or equivalent to minimize noise and must be placed on a hard, level surface (pavement, plywood). Have a fire extinguisher near, but not on top of, each generator in case of fire. If generators are to be fueled or refilled on site, they must be placed in a container in order to prevent hazardous materials from spilling into the soil. Generators may not be operated between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM.
- Night lighting is allowed for safety reasons only and lighting must be downcast and shielded to prevent light from spilling onto the water, beach, vegetation, or sky.
- Self-contained recreational vehicle camping is allowed only in the last four rows at the far end (first rows as you enter the parking lot) of the Brandy Creek Marina parking lot. All units must have fully self-contained toilet and wastewater devices, defined as apparatus permanently constructed within a motor vehicle for the purpose of collecting and storing human waste and wastewater for later disposal in a dump station or other device. A sanitary dump station and potable water is available at Brandy Creek RV Campground. Tents are not allowed. Pets must be kept in a cage or on a leash no more than 6 feet in length at all times; pets may not be left unattended. All food, pet food, beverage containers, toiletries, cooking utensils, dishes and other items with food odor must be stored inside of the vehicle unless they are in immediate use.
