The Organizing Authority (OA) is Del Rey Yacht Club (DRYC).

6 Fridays: April 8, May 20, June 17, July 15, August 19, September 16

Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

- **1.1** The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- **1.2** No spinnakers are allowed in this series.
- 1.3 Boats rated with movable ballast and power winches may use them (this changes RRS 51, 52).
- **1.4** RRS 81 will not apply.

2 COMMUNICATION

- **2.1** The official online notice board is located at dryc.org, under the racing tab.
- **2.2** While on the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make oral changes and broadcast information on VHF channel 68.

3 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FEES

- 3.1 This event is open to all sailboats 14' to 50' LOA.
- **3.2** A boat without a rating will be assigned one by the OA (see **9 HANDICAP RATINGS/SCORING**).
- 3.3 The entry deadline is 1500 each race day. Enter online at dryc.org, under the racing tab.
- **3.4** The entry fee is \$5 per race.

4 DIVISIONS and CLASSES

- **4.1** There may be 3 divisions, Performance, Cruising and Dinghy.
- **4.2** The OA may reassign a boat from the Cruising division to the Performance division.
- **4.3** The class splits, flags and time of the first warning will be posted on the RC boat by 1745 each race day.

5 SCHEDULE and VENUE

- **5.1** The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1755 (multiple sound signals 1 minute before).
- **5.2** The venue will be the Marina del Rey Harbor and it's entrances.

6 COURSE

- 6.1 After starting, sail out the main channel. An imaginary line connecting the "No Sail" buoys on the north and south sides of the entrance channel shall not be crossed.
- **6.2** Exit the marina through the North Entrance.

- **6.3** Leave MdR SS mark to port (see MdR Course Chart 17).
- **6.4** Return to the marina through the south entrance. An imaginary line connecting the "No Sail" buoys on the north side of the entrance channel shall not be crossed.
- **6.5** Proceed to the finishing line, center channel markers can be ignored.

7 THE START

The starting line will be near the entrance to C basin, between an orange flag on the RC boat and an orange flag or mark in the water.

8 THE FINISH

- **8.1** The finishing line will be between an orange flag on a boat slipped in DRYC's main channel dock and an orange flag or mark in the water.
- 8.2 Any boat not finishing by 1930 (time limit) will be scored DNF without a hearing (this changes RRS 35, A 4.2).

9 HANDICAP RATINGS/SCORING

- **9.1** A boat without a rating will be assigned one by the OA. Contact the Event Chairman no later than 24 hours before the race to receive a rating.
- **9.2** Non-spinnaker offsets shall not be applied.
- **9.3** The course distance is 4.5nm for the Performance and Cruising Divisions.

10 HEARING REQUESTS

- **10.1** A boat intending to file a protest, shall orally inform the RC when they finish or retire.
- **10.2** The protest time limit is 45 minutes after the protesting boat finishes or retires.
- **10.3** Protests shall be filed at the DRYC front desk. Hearings may be scheduled for a later date.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded after each race, based on the number of entries in each class and division.
- **11.2** Series and perpetual trophies will be presented after the final race of the series.
- 11.3 The "DRYC Sundown Series" Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the series winner of each division. The "DRYC Sundowner Trophy" will be awarded to the best series finish by a DRYC member in each division.
