

## Amended Notice of Race HALLOWEEN "MONSTER MASH" REGATTA! Saturday, October 22, 2022

Rules: This race shall be governed by the "Rules" as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

Eligibility and Entry: Yacht Club membership is NOT required. The race is open to OD, PHRF, and Cruisers.

**Entry Fee: \$25.00**. For Juniors racing dinghies there is **no entry** fee. Entries are available at www.dryc.org, US Sailing-Regatta Network or at DRYC.

**Notice to Competitors:** Any changes to this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the bulletin board on the right hallway inside the main entrance of the DRYC clubhouse. Notices available before race day may also be posted on the DRYC website (<a href="www.dryc.org">www.dryc.org</a>).

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be made available on-line on the DRYC website, Regatta Network, and at the club at least two days prior to the race.

Classes: Final classes and start times will be posted by 0900 Saturday, October 22 on the official notice board at DRYC and on Regatta Network

**Handicaps:** For PHRF and Cruiser Classes, Buoy Ratings for Area B1 will apply. Boats without a rating will be assigned one. Non-Spin offsets will apply where applicable.

**Starting Time and Location:** This will be a single race. The Warning Signal for the first boat(s) to start is scheduled for **1255.** The starting line will be set in the vicinity of "S" Mark, which is a yellow spar, approximately 1.5 NM bearing 235° from the middle of the Marina Del Rey detached breakwater. See **ASMBYC Chart #17**.

**Courses:** Outside the MDR detached breakwater: courses will consist of a number of marks which Boats shall round in any sequence and in either direction continuing inside the MDR detached breakwater and finishing in front of Del Rey Yacht Club. This will be a pursuit start. Keelboat course distance approximately 8.75NM.

**ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT:** PFD's (Type III or better performance when inflated) must be worn on all boats that do not have lifelines except for brief moments while changing clothing

Scoring: Low-Point Scoring system will be used.

**Trophies**: Trophies for this race will be awarded at DRYC after the race. There will be three trophies per class.

Halloween Party Info: There will be a post-race raffle and Taco Bar. Water and sodas for the kids are free. In addition, for both adults and Juniors races, there will be awards for the best costumes at the party and the best boat crew with costumes while racing.

There will be a Junior Racing Event inside the Marina sailing Optimists and all racers are advised that racing rules apply.
