



## Channel Islands to Marina del Rey Race

The Organizing Authorities (OA) are Channel Islands Yacht Club (CIYC) and Del Rey Yacht Club (DRYC).

September 24, 2022

### Notice of Race (NOR)

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Boats rated with movable ballast and power winches may use them (this changes RRS 51, 52).
- 1.3 [DP] While racing, all boats shall carry and monitor an operable VHF marine radio.

#### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available as stated in **NOR 6.1**.

#### 3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located online at [dryc.org](http://dryc.org), under the Racing tab.
- 3.2 On race day, the official notice board will be near the main entry of the Channel Islands Yacht Club.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 4.1 This event is open to boats with valid PHRF of So. Cal. ratings.
- 4.2 There will be 2 divisions, PHRF and Cruising.
- 4.3 The OA may reassign a boat from the Cruising division to the PHRF division.
- 4.4 Enter online at [dryc.org](http://dryc.org), under the Racing tab. Payment shall be made at time of registration.
- 4.5 Race entry and other deadlines are shown in **NOR 6.1**.

#### 5 FEES

The \$50 entry fee is due at time of registration. Late entries may be accepted with a \$25 late fee.

**6.2** The venue will be the Santa Barbara Channel and the Santa Monica Bay.

## **7 COURSE**

The course (44.7nm) will be from the starting line (near the Channel Islands Harbor north entrance), around Platform Gina, to the finishing line (near the Marina del Rey south entrance).

## **8 SCORNG**

The race will be scored using PHRF of So. Cal. base OWC ratings.

## **9 BERTHING and MOORING**

For CI Harbor and DRYC slip reservations go to dryc.org, select the Racing tab, Channel Islands to MdR Race, then Slip/Mooring Requests.

## **10 PRIZES**

**10.1** Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries in each class and division.

**10.2** Race and perpetual trophies will be presented at the awards presentation (see **NOR 6.1**).

## **11 HOSPITALITY**

**11.1** Friday afternoon, racers and family gather on the docks, followed by the CIYC Happy Hour at 1700. The famous “Beefeaters” Steak Dinner begins at 1830 (approx. \$25 per person)!

**11.2** Race-day, join us for the great CIYC breakfast, beginning at 0800 (approx. \$8 per person).

**11.3** Sunday morning, DRYC will host a continental breakfast and awards ceremony (see **NOR 6.1**).

**11.4** **Reservations are a must for all meals.** To reserve and pay, go to dryc.org, select the Racing tab, Channel Islands to MdR Race, then Meals. Submit before the deadline (**see NOR 6.1**)!
