

House Rules for Santana 22 Nationals at Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club

For the health and safety of all MPYC members, guests and staff and per house rules, Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club requires all visiting yachts, guests and crew to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination prior to accessing MPYC property. This includes the clubhouse, surrounding decks, dock and roof.

All members, volunteers and visitors to MPYC over the Santana 22 Nationals weekend will be required to wear green wrist bands that will indicate they have shown proof of vaccine to be at the Club.

Skippers will be asked to screen their crew prior to the start of the race and issue lime-green COVID-19 vaccine wrist bands to those crew who are <u>vaccinated only</u>. It is VERY important that skippers understand that by issuing a wrist band to a crew member, they are attesting to the vaccinated status of the individual and that the individual may be asked for proof of vaccine if accessing MPYC property.

Last minute or substitution crew may arrive to MPYC without a lime-green wristband and will be asked to show proof of vaccine prior to entrance onto MPYC property. They will be issued a wristband on site by the Health Officer on duty (or the concierge volunteer).

Visitors and family of crew will be asked to show proof of vaccine prior to entrance onto MPYC property and will be issued a wristband on site by the Health Officer on Duty (or the concierge volunteer).

Volunteers will not be required to wear masks indoors however, masks will be strongly recommended indoors when the club is busy. Masks will be available for volunteers.
