- 7.2 Crew weigh-in will be on March 10 0900 1200 and 1800-1900. Late crew weigh-in will be March 11 0700 0830 at Fort Worth Boat Club. Failure to weigh-in within the prescribed time limit may result in a boat being scored DNC for all races sailed any day(s) if any of a boat's competitors have not weighed in.

- 7.1 Boats and sails will be inspected the Class Measurer or his designee between 0900 and 1300 on March 10, 2022. Inspections will be limited to USCG safety equipment, weight certificate and sail tag number checks.
- 7.1.1 Boat inspections will be extended to March 0730 0830, prior to racing on March 12 at 1000. Failure to complete the Inspection -in within the prescribed time limit may result in a boat being scored DNC for all races sailed any day(s) if any of a boat's inspection not being signed off..
- 7.2.1 Crew weigh In for original crew weigh in (March 12) and approved crew changes will be between 0800 to 0830 on March 12 and 13. Failure to weigh-in within the prescribed time limit may result in a boat being scored DNC for all races sailed any day(s) if any of a boat's competitors have not weighed in prior to racing.
