Races will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the current prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, One Design Class when not in conflict with the forgoing and FYC Sailing Instructions. The 420 Class will be governed by the 2021-2024 Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) Procedural Rules (PR) unless otherwise specified in the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility and Entry

The Wet-n-Cool Regatta is a youth regatta and is open to all youth sailors who have not or will not reach their 19th birthday in the 2022 calendar year.

Scoring for the 420 Class will be in accordance with the ISSA PR, and rule 7.5 will apply regarding the number of races.
